GENERAL INFORMATION

The Center for Preparatory Studies was established and is operated by Nazarbayev University. Nazarbayev University Foundation Year Program is an academic year (two semesters) "foundational" year where students improve their knowledge of academic English, study Mathematics, and practice elementary Leadership skills so they are prepared to enter Nazarbayev University Undergraduate Schools. The language of instruction in CPS in all courses is English.

Progression to the University's undergraduate schools is based on their percentage grades in English, Mathematics, and Leadership. The three grade components are considered separately, i.e., there is no GPA.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic calendar consists of two semesters (Fall and Spring), 14 weeks each (not including mid-semester breaks and final exam periods).
